## Good Humanitarian Donorship Initiative – July 2008-July 2009: provisional work plan

In order to provide some further focus to activities in the framework of GHD, three main proposed over-arching themes for the next year are:

- 1. Enhancing Partnership reinforcing the humanitarian system model
- 2. Strengthening the operational/field focus of GHD donor coordination
- 3. Humanitarian financing and allocation based on identified need

With continued emphasis also on <u>individual good donorship mainstreaming</u> – where donors are duly encouraged to provide or update their individual GHD implementation plans; and on continued efforts to bring 'newer' donors more actively into humanitarian donorship dialogue.
